

Ultrasound Elastography (Hepatus 5 Liver Scan) - Patient Instructions

Ultrasound elastography, also known as the Hepatus 5 liver scan, is a non-invasive test used to measure the stiffness of your liver. It works by sending a series of gentle pulses of painless sound waves through the liver to assess liver health.

Patient Instructions:

- It is important to have your examination on an empty stomach. Do not eat or drink anything for at least 3 hours prior to your examination.
- No food, drink, gum, mints, or coffee. If you need to take medication, take it with a few sips of water.
- Wear comfortable clothing that allows easy access to the right side of your rib cage.
